In the year of 1963 the Department of Geography was established for Post Graduation and the first batch of M.A. students passed with nine students in 1965.

- The department is publishing *Indian Journal of Geography* since 1965, which has a wide national and international circulation with ISSN number of 0537-2011. Chief Editor of the Journal Prof. Rajendra Parihar, Editor Dr. Arjun Lal Meena, Assistant Editors Dr. Asha Rathore and Dr. Ashwani Arya works to enrich this journal with most relevant and innovative research work in the discipline of Geography.
- One of our faculty members Dr. Anamika Poonia's, Research Paper is in the top 25% of all research outputs ever tracked by Altmetric. Recently she also published a new Research in Taylor and Francis's "Urban Water Journal". Along with it she received "Young Geographer Award" at RGA 2019.
- Dr. Lalit Singh Jhala received "Young Geographer's Award" in 2008 by RGA.

### **REMOTE SENSING AND GIS**

- In the field of Remote Sensing and GIS the department is progressing significantly. In the year of 2018 a MoU was signed between Jai Narain Vyas University and Regional Remotes Sensing Centre of ISRO for Research collaboration between the faculties and students of these two institutes. The department of Geography played remarkable role in this MoU. Under the domain of this MoU joint Research Projects, joint PhD supervision, Knowledge dissemination can be taken up.
