8. Introduction of the Project: The project was to restore and maintenance of the botanical garden (front area) carried out by 8 students of M.Sc. previous year II sem. It included sweeping the garden, waste collection and disposal, pulling out of weed plants, watering old plants and planting new seeds. All the above mentioned activities were carried out/performed by the 8 members of the group for about 6 months, thrice a week for 1-2 hours in order to maintain the beauty of the botanical garden and spreading awareness about cleanliness.

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9. Objective: To prepare and maintain a clean, green and hygienic botanical garden for luxurious growth and conservation of variety of floral biodiversity.
10. Procedure adopted: The Department of Botany has a huge botanical garden. The area for work covered by our group was the front portion of the garden. The methodology we adopted was:
- i) All members gathered at the location at a particular time which was decided earlier.
 - ii) Some members were responsible for sweeping while some used to collect and dispose off waste. Some members pulled out weeds and yet other watered / planted the trees.
 - iii) All the members performed all the activities according to their chances which was already fixed one day prior on our Anandam whatsapp groups.
 - iv) Photographs were clicked by one member so as to upload them on the Anandam page on Instagram to motivate our followers to clean their surroundings.
 - v) The above mentioned activities were carried out for 1-2 hours every other day in order to maintain a clean garden.
