



ADDRESS OF PRESIDENT DR. S.S.TAK TO 44th GENERAL BODY MEETING HELD ON 19th Sept. 2021

Dear Members

I welcome you all on behalf of all office bearers and on my own behalf to 44th General Body meeting. First of all , on behalf of all office bearers, will like to thank from the Core of Our Hearts, the Alumni at large and members of Alumni Association for extending such a overwhelming support to us during last two years. What ever has been achieved in last two years is because of this hole Hearted support. I hope we have lived upto the Expectations of the Alumni.

As you know, the Present Executive Committee had taken over the charge in August 2019.

In addition to normal work of the Association, the Executive Committee had set for itself, three specific goals:

1. To strive for a more Effective and Efficient Administrative Structure for MBM Engineering College, being prerequisite for restoring old glory of MBM.
2. To restart Girls Hostel Project and make the Hostel operational .
3. To develop a network platform to connect maximum possible Alumni all over the world.

I will like to give you in brief the efforts made and the extent to which we could achieve these goals.

For effective and efficient Administrative structure for MBM, as has been informed in the earlier meeting we could convince the Hon. Chief Minister Shri Ashok ji Gehlot to grant University Status to MBM. He very kindly agreed to our request. The present status is that, the Council of Ministers had approved the Bill " MBM UNIVERSITY ACT 2021" and the Bill has been placed on the table of Assembly during budget session. However due to Second Wave of COVID19 the Assembly was adjourned abruptly and Bill could not be taken up by the Assembly . We are sure that " MBM UNIVERSITY ACT.2021 " will be approved in the Next Session of Assembly.

But for Covid 19, MBM would have become University by now. In the changed circumstances , we hope our this dream will become a reality by September/ October 2021 .

For Girls Hostel, it was decided that Our Priority should be to make our huge investment productive by completing at LEAST TWO FLOORS as early as possible.

I am extremely happy to inform that by the Grace of God, Blessings of our Teachers and all out Generous contribution by Alumni we have COMPLETED ALL THE THREE FLOORS.

NOT ONLY THAT WE HAVE REPLENISHED THE CORPUS FUND FROM WHICH a SUM of MORE THAN Rs. 1 CRORE was drawn for this purpose in the past.

This is the result of efficient, transparent and economical handling of the Project by our Building Committee Headed by Er Jai Singh Choudary. Our heartfelt Appreciation for All the members of Building Committee.

In short upto 31st March 21 a sum of Rs 6.5 Crores has been spent on Girls Hostel, of which Rs 2.00 Crores were contributed by Shree Cement, of the remaining Rs 4.5 Crores, Rs 3.5 Crores have been contributed by the Alumni during tenure of present Executive Committee, that too upto 31st March 21. After March Association has further received Rs 50 lakh making a total of Rs 4.0 Crores only under this head during last two years.

WE SALUTE ALL THE GENEROUS CONTRIBUTORS in General and in Particular ,Prof. R . R. Tatia & family (Mrs. Shashi, Anand and Gaurav Tatia) contributing Rs.40 lakh , Er Suresh Modi & family of Metalizing Equipment contributing Rs.31 lakh, Er Harendra Singh of H. G. Infrastructure Ltd contributing Rs.25 lakh and Er Surendra Surana Rs 11 lakh.

Our former teachers including Prof. Tatia blessed us with a contribution of Rs 70 lakhs.

Amongst the batches 1968 batch contributed Rs 60 lakh prior to 2019 and further added Rs 11 lakhs making a total of Rs. 71 lakhs, 1974 batch contributed Rs 30 lakh, 1969 batch contributed Rs 20 lakh, 1977 batch contributed Rs 23 lakh and 1990 batch contributed Rs 20 lakh ,We highly appreciate the efforts made by coordinators of 1968 Dr. G. C. Kothari, 1969 Er KML Mathur & V. N. Bansal, 1974 Er Sohan Bhutra & Er Akash Mehta , 1977 Dr P. C. Purohit and 1990 Er Dinesh Goyal.

We thank ALL BATCH COORDINATORS for their kind support in mobilising the contribution from their batch mates. The list of Batches, contributing for a Room/Rooms and Individuals contributing more than Rs 1.0 lakh has been printed in the News Letter and name of each and every contributor is available in excel sheet attached herewith.

WORDS ARE NOT ENOUGH TO EXPRESS OUR GRATITUDE TO THE CONTRIBUTORS FOR THEIR GENEROUS AND GRACIOUS CONTRIBUTION. LET US GIVE THEM ALL A STANDING OVATION.

For the furniture of Girls Hostel, Hon. Vice-Chancellor was kind enough to sanction Rs 18 lakhs in October 2020. However, this grant was not utilized in last financial year for reasons best known to people responsible for it. Hon. VC has renewed this grant recently on our request and we hope that Furniture will be procured soon.

As you are aware two waves of pandemic COVID19 resulted in a Nation wide LOCKDOWNS bringing every thing to a halt for a very long time and causing lots of suffering.

We can say with Pride that we were Among the FIRST FEW PROFESSIONAL Bodies which came forward to Help fight this dreaded pandemic. Even Institution of Engineers gave call almost a month after.

I CONGRATULATE Alumni for contributing so Generous for this Social Cause. Their response was far beyond our initial expectations. Alumni contributed more than Rs 50 lakh for COVID19 Help Fund. Association provided PPE kits. Masks and Sanitizer during the first wave and a Oxygen Plant and 20 Oxygen Concentrators during the Second Wave. USA Alumni contributed more than Rs 30 lakh for this cause. We thank them from core of our hearts. Our Heartfelt Appreciation for Er Mahesh Soni and Er Sanjay Sharma for reaching out to Front line Covid workers risking their own health during the first wave of COVID19.

During last two years we have added Rs 16 lakh to Corpus of Permanent scholarships. The Adhoc Scholarships awarded were all time high, more than Rs 7.5 lakh in two years. Adoption by Er B. L. Mohata continued averaging more than Rs 3.00 lakh per annum.

Association have now FCRA registration and therefore can receive funds from overseas directly in foreign currency. Just in last two months we have received about Rs 30 lakh through this account. Our Heartfelt Appreciation for Prof. (Dr.) Ramesh Chandra Joshi 55 batch for contributing more than Rs 18.00 lakh as first contribution in FCRA ACCOUNT.

I hope you all are aware that we have renovated Our Association Office including much needed repair and maintenance costing about Rs 5.5 lakh.

It gives me a great satisfaction to inform you that financial health of the Association has improved considerably in last two years. As of today we have FDs for more than Rs 3.0 Crores against the Rs 1.25 Crores when this EC assumed the charge.

All this has become possible because we could reach out to much larger number of Alumni. We are trying to expand it further using IT tools, yet we need to do a lot in this area. Our new website with many new features is ready . It has been developed in house. We highly appreciate the hard work put in by Er O.P. Madhvi 68 batch for this development. I will request you all and the Alumni at large to register themselves on this website for better communication.

My sincere apologies to the institutors of Gold Medals for not awarding the Gold Medals in last two years. No excuses. However, I wish to assure them that ALL these pending Gold Medals will be awarded this year. We have made a provision for the same in budget of 2021-22.

All these achievements have generated new expectations from Alumni Association, in MBM fraternity . I am sure Association with the cooperation of Alumni worldwide, will Live Up to these expectations.

I will earnestly request you all to motivate all our Alumni who have as yet not taken the Membership of Alumni Association to become Life Member of Association.

I once again welcome you to this 44th General Body Meeting.

Honorary Secretary's Report for The year 2020-21

Dear Members,

It is my privilege to place before you the annual report of The Association for kind consideration.

1. During the period association functioned through one AGM (43rd AGM held on 21st Feb. 2021), well attended 6 Executive committee meetings (6th ECM held on 25th July 2020, 7th ECM held on 20th Sep. 2020, 8th ECM held on 29th Nov. 2020, Emergent ECM held on 19 Jun. 2021, 9th ECM held on 2 March 2021, 10th ECM held on 18th July 2021) on Physical as well as E- Platforms.
2. The following decisions were taken by ECM and implemented.
 - (a) The Period under consideration was affected by covid-19 surges and our Association has decided to carryout massive covid relief work as a social responsibility. During the said period 300 PPT Kits with goggles, gloves and shoes, 4000 Masks, 2 No. Tunnels and 350 washable kits, 30 oximeters, 200 N95 and 700 reusable Masks and 1000 face shields, 500 Protection kits. were distributed among various covid centers. 20 No. Oxygen concentrators and one oxygen Plant were also provided to the hospitals, which were found to be very useful.
 - (b) Girls hostel Project was complete after resolving all disputes and measures were also taken. Therefore, section for 13 essential items amounting to Rs 46.13 lacs were issued in the 7th ECM held on 20th Sept. 2020 to operationalisethe Girls hostel. It is happy to inform that work of most of items have been completed.
 - (c) To invite foreign contribution from the alumni, application for FCRA account operation was sent to GOI and happy to inform that sanction has been accorded, account opened and so for an amount of Rs. 30 lacs has been received in the Account.
 - (d) Resolution was passed in the ECM for thanks giving the Govt. of Rajasthan for Promulgation of Act. to declare MBM as University in the Rajasthan State legislative Assembly. By the time we meet in the AGM the Act might have passed and it is matter of great pleasure for all of us.
 - (e) One of our Alumni Er. Ashwini Vaishnav, Rajya Sabha member has been appointed as Railway Minister of India. It is a matter of pride for the alma matter and all alumni. the Association Congratulated him.
3. The budget for this financial year has been approved by the 10th ECM held on 17th July 2021 with enhanced Provision for office-improvement, Sports activities, green and clean campus drive and innovation start-ups.
4. The 10th ECM held on 17th July 2021 has extended nomination of existing President, Hony. Secretary and Treasurer for the next session 2021-23.
5. The Foundation Day of the college was celebrated on 14th Aug. 2021 with launching of green and clean campus drive by plantation in Departments by the chief Guest Er. G. S. Bhandari and Vice Chancellor Prof. P.C. Trivedi, the function was well attended by alumni and the faculty.
6. Due to covid situation during the said period the committee formed couldn't meet regularly, but they deliberated on e-platform and recommended actionable plans.

7. Distribution of Scholarship and medals have been our important activity and reforming the Process has been felt necessary, therefore a high-power committee has been constituted.
8. Diminishing faculty positions in college have been embracing to the prestige of the this highly positioned institute. the legal hassles and other rare nation – wide hurdles among all universities are well known. the matter has been taken-up with vice chancellor and Govt. several times. and solution to problem is likely in near future.
9. Accreditation of institute is our long pending demand and international obligation. the matter has been taken-up with vice chancellor. Process has been initiated. and happy to inform that 3 departments have been accredited
10. Many of our members have done spectacular achievements in these sessions this includes distinguished alumni have been chosen to head the stated organizations of the nation. Excellency award and achievement are numerous. several have authored books on important topics.

The executive committee for 2019-2021 unanimously thanks all those who have contributed for the alma mater in their unique and diverse ways, that has kept our morale high and motivated all the alumni to strive for upholding the flag of MBM high and flying. We shall look forward and to receiving the same cooperation in all the future endeavours of the association with profound regards

1. Agenda item No 1- meeting called to the order:

2. Agenda item No. 2 : Establishment of Quorum :

3. Meeting started after prayer.

5. Agenda item No.3- Presidents Address:

The President welcomed all the members and appraised them regarding the following developments.

(ii) With the overwhelming support of Alumni, the Girls Hostel Project has been completed. With our Mission LET US DO IT we hope to even replenish Corpus Fund loan of Rs 1.16 Cr very soon. Requested Alumni to help in accomplishing this Mission as well.

(iii) The inhouse developed new Web Site is ready. Process of Data entry is in progress. Request all Alumni to Register/ Update their data on it.

6. Agenda item No 5 : to confirm the minutes of 42er AGM held on 04-08-2019

The minutes of 42rd AGM were presented by the Honorary Secretary along with Action taken report and same were confirmed by the house unanimously.

7. Agenda item No.6: To receive and adopt (with modification if any) The Honorary secretary's Report:

(Report circulated with agenda)

Honorary secretary DR. R.K Vishnoi presented the report before the house. The same was approved by the house unanimously.

8. Agenda item No.7: To consider and pass the audited accounts for the financial year 2019-2020.

The audited balance sheet (As circulated with agenda) was presented by the Treasurer Shri Pardeep Kumar. The audited accounts were approved unanimously by the House.

9. Agenda item No. 8: TO approve the appointment of auditors for the financial year 2020-2021:

The house approved the appointment of the auditor M/S Jain and Kachhawaha, chartered Accountants on existing remuneration.

10. Agenda item No. 9. To consider and adopt budget for 2020-2021:

The house Considered the budget presented by the Treasurer. The president explicitly informed that a provision of Rs. 4.5 lacs has been made for renovation of office building . Budget was approved unanimously.

11. To create new endowment fund for green-clean campus and start-up programme:

The agenda was presented to the house and was approved unanimously.

12. Agenda item No.11. To pass resolution,(if any):

The following resolutions were presented and adopted

- (i) Prof. Gautam Kothari presented a resolution for reorganization of balance sheet.
- (ii) President alumni association presented that the fund of the association by reorganized in logical frame work.

The house unanimously authorized the Office Bearers to do the needful.

13. Other items with the permission of chair.

The following points were taken-up for discussions and adoption.

- (i) Er. Nem Raj Mehta suggested to operationalise the girls hostels constructed at an earliest. The president welcomed the suggestion and informed that association has already informed the university to start the hostel but due to covid situations the college is yet to start fully physically.
 - (ii) Prof OP Madhvi requested all members to check their self data on newly created website and upload their recent photographs.
 - (iii) Er. P. R. Dave suggested to create skill development center in each department on the line of mining department.
 - (iv) Prof. Ravi Saxena requested to address the problems of the college and departments. It was informed that despite repeated communications with college authorities, no specific requirements have been submitted. Therefore Prof. Saxena was requested to work as brigde between college and association being common interface.
 - (v) Past president Er. Satish Choudhary suggested that
