**NOTIFICATION**

It is hereby notified that the Hon'ble Chancellor under Section 24(1) of Jai Narain Vyas University Act 1962 as amended from time to time has assented to Ordinance No. 317 for Open Selection for teachers as detailed below and communicated by the Principal Secretary to Governor, Rajasthan vide his letter No. F.2(6)RB/2007/4041 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept., 2011:-

**Ordinance 317  
(For Open Selection)**

Minimum qualifications for the post of Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors in subjects other than Management, Engineering and technology, Directors, Deputy Directors, Assistant Directors of Physical Education, Librarians, Deputy Librarians, Assistant Librarians for appointment through open selection will be as prescribed herein under the Ordinance.

Arts, Humanities, Sciences, Social Sciences, Commerce, Education, Languages, Law, Journalism and Mass Communication, Music, Fine Arts & Painting.

**(1) PROFESSOR**

- A. (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/ allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/ industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology - mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in table IIC & table I of Appendix III of the UGC Regulations, 2010 as amended from time to time.

OR

B. An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned / allied / relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

**MUSIC**

- i. An eminent scholar with a doctoral degree actively and engaged in research with ten years of experience in teaching in University / College and / or research at the University / National level institutions including experience of guiding research at doctoral level with outstanding performing achievements in the field of specialization

OR

ii A traditional and a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should be or have:

- (a) 'A' grade artist of AIR/TV
- (b) Twelve years of outstanding performing achievements in the field of specialization.
- (c) Significant contributions in the field of specializations and ability to guide research;
- (d) Participation in National / International Seminars/Conference/ Workshops and/ or recipient of National/ International Awards/Fellowships; and
- (e) Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

### **FINE ARTS & PAINTING**

i. An eminent scholar with a doctoral degree actively engaged in research with ten years of experience in teaching and /or research at the University/National level institutions including experience of guiding research in doctoral level, with outstanding performing achievement in the field of specialization.

OR

ii. A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:

1. Twelve years of experience of holding regular regional/national exhibition/ workshops with evidence;
2. Significant contributions in the field of specialization and ability to guide research;
3. Participation in National/International Seminars/Conferences/ Workshops and/or recipient of National/International Awards/ Fellowships; and
4. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

### **EDUCATION**

a. A Master's Degree in Arts / Humanities / Sciences / Commerce and M. Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed),

OR

M. A. (Education) with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and B. Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);

b. Ph. D. in Education; and

c. At least ten years of teaching experience in University department of education or College of Education of which a minimum of five years at the M. Ed. level with published work in the area of his specialization.

#### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

a. A Master's Degree in Physical Education with a minimum of 55% (marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);

b. Ph.D. in Physical Education or equivalent published work; and

c. At least ten years teaching / research experience in a department / college of Physical Education out of which at least five years in the post graduate institution / University department

#### (2). Associate Professor

i. Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.

ii. A Master's Degree in relevant subject with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale, wherever grading system is followed).

iii. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.

iv. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology - mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.

v. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in table IIC & table I of Appendix III of the UGC Regulations, 2010 as amended from time to time.

#### MUSIC

i. Good academic record with doctoral degree, with performing ability of high professional standard.

ii. Eight years of experience of teaching at the University / College level and/or research in University/national level institutions excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degree.

- iii. Has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the subject concerned, as evidenced by quality of publications.
- iv. Contribution to educational innovation such as designing of new courses, curricula - and/or outstanding performing achievement in the field of specialization.

OR

- i. A traditional and a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should be or have:

(a) 'A' grade artist of AIR/TV; (b) Eight years of outstanding performing achievements in the field of specialization; (c) Experience in designing of new courses and /or curricula; (d) Participation in Seminars/Conferences in reputed institutions; and (e) Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

#### **FINE ARTS AND PAINTING**

- i. Good academic record with doctoral degree, with performing ability of high professional standard.
- ii. Eight years of experience of teaching in a University / College and/ or research in University / national level institutions excluding the period spent for the research degree of M.Phil./ Ph. D.
- iii. Has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the subject concerned as evidenced by quality of publications.
- iv. Contributions to educational innovation such as: designing new courses and/or curricula and/of outstanding performing achievements in the field of specializations.

OR

- i. A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:

- a. A recognized artist of his/her own discipline;
- b. Eight years of outstanding performing achievements in the field of specialization;
- c. Experience in designing of new courses and /or curricula;
- d. Participation in Seminars/Conferences in reputed institutions; and
- e. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

## EDUCATION

a. A Master's Degree in Arts / Humanities / Sciences / Commerce and M. Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed),

OR

M. A. (Education) and B. Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);

b. Ph. D. in Education; and

c. At least eight years of teaching experience in University department of education or College of Education, with a minimum of three years at the M. Ed. level and has published work in the relevant area of specialization.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

a. A Master's Degree in Physical Education with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

b. At least eight years teaching / research experience in a department / college of Physical Education out of which at least three years in the post graduate level; and

c. Ph.D. in Physical Education or Equivalent published work.

## (3) ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

Note:

i. The candidates, who are admitted/awarded the Ph.D. degree prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 as amended from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor.

ii. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

## MUSIC

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC.

Or

A traditional and a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have: (a) Studied under noted/reputed traditional masters and has thorough knowledge to explain the subject concerned; (b) A high grade artist of AIR/TV; and (c) Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

### Note:

- i. The candidates, who are admitted/awarded the Ph.D. degree prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 or have been awarded Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 as amended from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities.
- ii. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

## FINE ARTS & PAINTING

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree level, in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/Foreign University.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC.

OR

A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:

1. First class Diploma in Visual (Fine) arts discipline from the recognized Institution of India/Abroad;
2. Five years of experience of holding regular regional/National exhibitions/Workshops with evidence; and

3. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

**Note :**

- i. The candidates, who are admitted/awarded the Ph.D. degree prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree, in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, as amended from time to time, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities.
- ii. Without prejudice to the above, NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**EDUCATION**

- a. A Master's Degree in Arts / Humanities / Sciences / Commerce and M. Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed),

OR

- M. A. (Education) and B. Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and
- b. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC from time to time for the positions of Assistant Professors, shall be mandatory.

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

- a. A Master's Degree in Physical Education with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and
- b. Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC from time to time for the position of Assistant Professors, shall be mandatory

**DIRECTOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

- (i) A Ph.D. in Physical Education.
- (ii) Experience of at least ten years as University Deputy Director or fifteen years as University Assistant DPEs/College (Stage 3).
- (iii) Participation in at least two national /international seminars/conferences.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in table V(C) & table IV of Appendix III of the UGC Regulation, 2010 as amended from time to time.
- (v) Evidence of organizing competitions and conducting coaching camps of at least two weeks' duration.

- (vi) Evidence of having produced good performance teams/athletes for competitions like state/national/inter-university/combined university, etc.,

#### **DEPUTY DIRECTOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

- (i) A Ph.D. in Physical Education. Candidates from outside the university system, in addition, shall also possess at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level by the university concerned.
- (ii) Eight years experience as University Assistant DPES/College DPES, with a benefit of two years and one year for Ph.D. and M.Phil. Degree holders.
- (iii) Evidence of organizing competitions and conducting coaching camps of at least two weeks duration.
- (iv) Evidence of having produced good performance teams/athletes for competitions like state / national / inter-university / combined university, etc.
- (v) Passed the physical fitness test in accordance with the Ordinance.
- (vi) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in table V(C) & table IV of Appendix III of the UGC Regulation, 2010 as amended from time to time.

#### **ASSISTANT DIRECTOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

- i. A Master's Degree in Physical Education or Master's Degree in Sports Science with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) with a consistently good academic record.
- ii. Record of having represented the university / college at the inter-university /intercollegiate competitions or the State and/ or national championships.
- iii. Qualifying in the national level test conducted for the purpose by the UGC or any other agency approved by the UGC.
- iv. Passed the physical fitness test.

#### **Note:**

The candidates, who are admitted/awarded the Ph.D. degree prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 or have been awarded Ph. D. degree in accordance with the "University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulations 2009, as amended from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of University Assistant Director of Physical Education.

#### **PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST NORMS**

- (a) Subject to the provisions of these Regulations, all candidates who are required to undertake the physical fitness test shall be required to produce a medical certificate certifying that he/she is medically fit before undertaking such tests.
- (b) On production of such certificate mentioned in sub-clause (a) above, the candidate would be required to undertake the physical fitness test in accordance with the following norms.



## NORMS FOR MEN

12 MINUTES RUN/WALK TEST	
Up to 30 years	1800 metres
Up to 40 years	1500 metres
Up to 45 years	1200 metres
Up to 50 years	800 metres

## NORMS FOR WOMEN

### 8 MINUTES RUN / WALK TEST

Up to 30 years	1000 Metres
Up to 40 years	800 metres,
Up to 45 years	600 metres
Up to 50 years	400 metres.

## LIBRARIAN

- i. A Master's Degree in Library Science /Information Science/documentation with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC seven points scale and A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in table VIII (c) & table VII of Appendix III of UGC Regulations, 2010 as amended from time to time.
- ii. At least thirteen years as a Deputy Librarian in a university library or eighteen years' experience as a College Librarian.
- iii. Evidence of innovative library service and organization of published work.
- iv. Desirable: M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree in library science/information science / documentation/achieves and manuscript-keeping.

## DEPUTY LIBRARIAN

- i. A Master's Degree in library science/information science/documentation with at least 55% of the marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC seven point scale and A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in table VIII (c) & table VII of Appendix III of UGC Regulations, 2010 as amended from time to time.
- ii. Five years experience as an Assistant University Librarian/College Librarian.
- iii. Evidence of innovative library service and organization of published work and professional commitment, computerization of library.
- iv. Desirable: M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree in library science/Information science / Documentation/ Archives and manuscript-keeping/computerization of library

## ASSISTANT LIBRARIAN

- i. A Master's Degree in Library Science / Information Science / Documentation Science or an equivalent professional degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and a consistently good academic record with knowledge of computerization of library.
- ii. Qualifying in the national level test conducted for the purpose by the UGC or any other agency approved by the UGC.

### Note:

The candidates, who are admitted/awarded the Ph.D. degree prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 or have been awarded Ph. D. degree in accordance with the "University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulations 2009 as amended from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Librarian.

### Note:

1. A relaxation of 5% will be given at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste /Scheduled Tribe/ Differently-abled (Physically and visually/ differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark.
2. A relaxation of 5% will be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) will be required at the Master's level for those recruited as teachers at any level from industries and research institutions and at the entry level of Assistant Professors, Assistant Librarians, Assistant Directors of Physical Education. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.
4. The candidate for the post Assistant Professor must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET. The candidates, who are admitted/awarded the Ph.D. degree prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree, in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, as amended from time to time, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges / Institutions. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

5. The minimum requirement of 55% shall not be insisted upon, for Professors, Readers, Directors of physical Education and Dy. Director of Physical Education, Dy. Librarian, Librarian, existing incumbents who are already in the University system. However, these marks should be insisted upon for those entering the system from outside and those at the entry point of Lecturers, Assistant Directors of Physical Education.

6. A relaxation of the minimum marks at the PG level from 55% to 50% for appointment as Lecturer may be provided to the candidates who have cleared the JRF examination conducted by UGC / CSIR only, prior to 1989 when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF exam were 50%.

7. The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/ research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions

### GOOD ACADEMIC RECORD (FOR DIRECT RECRUITMENT)

FACULTY OF LAW, ARTS EDUCATION & SOCIAL SCIENCES, SCIENCE, COMMERCE

Good academic record means at least II<sup>nd</sup> Division either at secondary or Sr. Secondary / Higher Secondary level and at graduate level.

### SEVEN POINTS SCALE

It is clarified that where the University/ College /Institution declare results in grade points which is on a scale of seven, the following mechanism will be referred to ascertain equivalent marks in percentage:
