**NOTIFICATION**

It is hereby notified that the Hon'ble Chancellor under Section 24 (1) of Jai Narain Vyas University Act 1962 as amended from time to time has assented to Ordinance No.317(B) for promotion to the teachers, who became eligible up to 30.12.2008 as detailed below and communicated by the Principal Secretary to Governor, Rajasthan vide his letter No.F 2 (6) RB/2007/U.S./84 dated 13.2.2011:-

**Ordinance 317 (B):**

**Professor (Promotion)**

In addition to the sanctioned position of Professors, which must be filled in through direct recruitment through all India advertisements, promotions may be made from the post of Reader to that of Professor after 8 years of service as Associate Professor (Reader), selected or promoted.

OR

If the number of years required in a feeder cadre are less than 8 years (those stipulated in UGC notification) thus, entailing hardship to those who have completed more than the total number of years in their entire service for eligibility in the cadre, then after adjusting the total number of years of service, such teacher will be eligible for promotion to the post of Professor.

**NOTE:** For movement into grade of Reader and above, the minimum eligibility criteria would be Ph.D.

Promotion to the post of Professor will be through a process of selection by the Statutory Selection Committee which shall be the same as for direct recruitment as defined under Section 5(1) of the Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers (Selection for appointment) Act, 1974 (Act No. 18 of 1974) as amended from time to time. The quorum required for the meeting of the selection committee shall be as provided under Section 6 of the Rajasthan Universities' Teachers and Officers Act, 1974 as amended from time to time.

**NOTE:** In addition to the above, UGC observer may be invited

For the promotion from Associate Professor (Reader) to Professor, the following method of promotion may be followed.

The Candidate should present herself/ himself before the selection Committee with some of the following:

- a) Self appraisal reports
- b) Research Contribution / books/articles published.

The best five research publications, out of which two could be the books, of the teacher (as defined by her/him) may be assessed before the interview by three eminent experts in the subject these experts shall be different than those called for interview to be conducted later on. However, all the recommendation should be positive from the three experts. In case the recommendation of one out of the three is negative, the research publications be sent to the fourth expert for evaluation and assessment, in all, there has to be a minimum of three positive recommendations out of the total of four experts, otherwise he/she shall not be eligible for interview. Evaluation report of the expert saying whether the research publications are recommended or not recommended be presented in separate column.

The candidate should be asked to submit these in 05 sets with the self appraisal report.

- c) Any other academic contributions.
- d) Seminar/Conferences attended.
- e) Contribution to teaching/academic/environment/ institutional corporate life.
- f) Extension and field outreach activities.

The repeat process of promotion for the rejected candidates can be conducted only after a minimum period of one year from the date of promotion process / interview in which the candidate was rejected.

Note: The above mentioned criteria for promotion to the post of Professor will be effective from 01/03/2002.

#### **ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (READER) PROMOTION:**

An Assistant Professor (Lecturer) in the Senior Scale will be eligible for promotion to the post of Associate Professor (Reader) if he/she has:

- (i) Completed 5 years of service in the senior scale ;

OR

If the number of years required in a feeder cadre are less than 5 years entailing hardship to those who have completed more than the total number of years in their entire service for eligibility in the cadre, then after adjusting the total number of years of service, such teacher will be eligible for promotion to the post of Associate Professor.

**NOTE:** - For movement into grades of Reader and above, the minimum eligibility criteria would be Ph.D., Those without Ph.D. can go up to the level of Lecturer (Selection Grade).

(ii) Obtained a Ph.D. degree

(iii) Made some mark in the areas of scholarship and research as evidenced e.g. by self assessment, reports of referees, (which should involve inviting the bio-data and reprints of three major publications of the candidate before interview and getting them assessed by the same three external experts, who are to be invited to interview the candidate) quality of publications, contribution to educational innovation, design of new courses and curricula and extension activities.

(iv) After placement in the Senior Scale participated in two refresher courses/summer institutes of approved duration, or engaged in other appropriate continuing education programmes of comparable quality as may be specified or approved by the University Grants Commission; and

(v) Possess consistently good performance appraisal reports.

Promotion to the post of Associate Professor (Reader) / and placement in selection scale Assistant Professor (Lecturer) will be through a process of selection by the Statutory Selection Committee which shall be the same as those for direct recruitment as defined under Section 5(1) of the Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers (Selection for appointment) Act, 1974 (Act No. 18 of 1974) as amended from time to time.

The quorum required for the meeting of the selection committee shall be as provided under Section 6 of the Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers Act, 1974 as amended from time to time.

#### **Lecturer/Assistant Professor (Selection Grade)**

Lecturers in the Senior Scale who do not have a Ph.D. degree or equivalent published work, and who do not meet the scholarship and research standards, but fulfil the other criteria given above for the post of Reader, and have a good record in teaching and preferably, have contributed in various ways such as to the corporate life of the institution, examination work, or through extension activities, will be placed in the Selection Grade, subject to the recommendations of the Selection Committee which is the same as for promotion to the post of Reader. They will be designated as Lecturer in the Selection Grade. They could offer themselves for fresh assessment after obtaining Ph.D. and / or fulfilling other requirements for promotion as Reader and, if found suitable, could be given the designation of Reader.

### Lecturer/Assistant Professor (Senior Scale)

A Lecturer will be eligible for placement in a Senior Scale through a procedure of Selection if she /he has :

- i) A Completed 06 years of service after regular appointment with relaxation of one year and two years, respectively, for those with M.Phil and Ph.D.
- ii) Participated in one orientation course and one refresher course of approved duration, or engaged in other appropriate continuing education programmes of comparable quality as may be specified or approved by the University grants commission. (Those with Ph.D. degree would be exempted from one refresher course)
- iii) Consistently satisfactory performance appraisal reports.

### Director Physical Education

1. Ph. D. in Physical Education
2. Experience of atleast ten years as University Deputy or fifteen years as University / College Assistant DPES (Selection Grade)
3. Participation in at least two national / international seminars/ conferences.
4. Consistently good appraisal report
5. Evidence of organizing competition and conducting coaching camps of atleast two week's duration.
6. Evidence of having produced good performance teams / athletes for competitions like state / national / inter-university / combined University etc.

### Dy. Director Physical Education(Promotion) Reader's Scale

1. Ph.D. in Physical Education Candidates from outside the University system, in addition, shall also possess at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the UGC 7 point scale at the Master's Degree level.
2. Five years experience as University / College Assistant DPES with a benefit of two years and one year for Ph.D. and M. Phil Degree holders.
3. Evidence of organizing competitions and conducting coaching camps of atleast two weeks duration.
4. Evidence of having produced good performance teams athletes for competitions like state / national / inter university combined university, etc.
5. Passed the physical fitness test
6. Consistently good appraisal reports.

### Assistant Director Physical Education (Selection Grade)

1. Completed five years of service as University Asstt. DPEs/College DPE in the Senior scale
2. Has attended at least two refresher courses of about three four weeks duration with proper and well defined evaluation procedure after placement in the senior scale
3. Shown evidence of having produced good teams / athletes and of having organized and conducted coaching camps of at least two weeks duration
4. Passed the Physical fitness test
5. Consistently good appraisal reports.

### Assistant Director Physical Education (Senior Grade)

1. Should have completed six years of service as University Assistant DPEs with a benefit of two years for Ph.D. and one year for M.Phil Degree holders.
2. Passed the Physical fitness test
3. Consistently good appraisal reports
4. Should have attended at least one orientation and one refresher course of about three to four weeks' duration each with proper and well defined evaluation procedure (exemption from one refresher course is granted to Ph.D degree holders)

Note: *This Ordinance will be applicable to those candidates who became eligible for promotion up to 30/12/2008 as per stipulation made in UGC Regulation (Minimum Qualifications Required for Appointment and Career Advancement of Teachers in Universities and institutions affiliated to it) 2010 & Government letter dated 22/09/2010 or up to the date, if declared by the UGC otherwise, in future*
