GENERAL NOTE:

1. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
2. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master 's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. The Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor in University with effect from 01.07.2021.
4. The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/ research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/ promotion. Regular faculty members upto twenty per cent of the total faculty strength (excluding faculty on medical / maternity leave) shall be allowed by their respective institutions to take study leave for pursuing Ph.D. degree.]
5. Weightages in selection committee to be considered along with other specified eligibility qualifications as stipulated in this ordinance should be in accordance of Appendix II, Table 2 of the UGC notification and appended as Table 1 with this Ordinance 317.
Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for Universities (reproduced as Table 2 in with this Ordinance 317) shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview for the post of Assistant Professor/ Assistant Director, Physical Education/ Assistant Librarian
6. The norms for counting of Past Services for Direct Recruitment shall be as per section 10.1 of UGC regulations, 2018 as amended from time to time.
7. In case of any deviation/ discrepancy in the above ordinance with reference to UGC regulation as notified in *The Gazette of India: Extraordinary dated 18th July 2018*, the Gazette version shall prevail

Discretionary award of advance increments for those who enter the profession as Associate Professor or Professor with higher merit, high number of research publications of high quality and experience at the appropriate level, shall be within the competence of the appropriate authority of the University based on the recommendations of a selection committee while considering the case of individual candidates in the context of the merits of each case, taking into account the pay structure of other teachers in the faculty and other merit- specific factors. Discretionary award of advance increments is not applicable to those entering the profession as Assistant Professor/Assistant Librarian/ Assistant Director of Physical Education and Sports and to those who are entitled for grant of advance increments for having acquired a Ph. D., M. Phil. or M.Tech. and LLM degree. However, those entering the service as Assistant Professor/Assistant Librarian/ Assistant Director of Physical Education and Sports, having a post-doctoral teaching/ research experience, after obtaining a Ph.D. degree and proven credentials, may be eligible for discretionary award of advanced increments to be given to the person, as decided and recorded by the Selection Committee in the minutes of its meeting.

In all the Selection Committees of direct recruitment of teachers and other academic staff in University provided herein, an academician belonging to the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/ OBC/ Minority/ Women/ Differently-abled categories, if any of candidates belonging to these categories is the applicant and if any of the members of the selection committee does not belong to that category, shall be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor, and in case of a College,

Vice-Chancellor of the University to which the college is affiliated to. The academician, so nominated for this purpose, shall be one level above the cadre level of the applicant, and such nominee shall ensure that the norms of the State Government, in relation to the categories mentioned above, are strictly followed during the selection process.

In the selection process for the posts involving different nature of responsibilities in certain disciplines/areas, such as Music and Fine Arts, Visual Arts and Performing Arts, Physical Education and Sports, and Library, greater emphasis may be laid on the nature of deliverables indicated against each of the posts in this Regulations which need to be taken up by the University in the Proforma for both the direct recruitment and the CAS promotion.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) established in the University as per the UGC/ National Assessment Accreditation Council (NAAC) guidelines with the Vice-Chancellor, as Chairperson shall act as the documentation and record-keeping Cell for the University, including assistance in the development of Assessment Criteria and Methodology Proforma based on these Regulations. The IQAC may also introduce, wherever feasible, the student feedback system as per the NAAC guidelines on institutional parameters without incorporating the component of the students' assessment of individual teachers in the Assessment Criteria and Methodology Proforma.

It is clarified that wherever (University/ College/ Institution) the grading system is followed by a recognized Organization at the levels that are considered for Academic score, the guidelines provided by that Organization shall be considered valid for grade conversation to percentage accordingly the Academic score(s). In case where there are no guidelines of grade conversation, the general principal of 95% computation shall be followed as advocated by CBSE/UPSC.
