## Examination Scheme for MPET-2022

**1. Introduction:** The MPET-2022 examination will be conducted on the basis of Ordinance approved by the Hon'ble Chancellor and communicated by the Principal Secretary to Governor, Rajasthan vide letter No.F.2(6) RB/2017/part2/4590 dated 14.12.2020 notified by the University vide notification No. JNVU/Aca/R/21/18840 dated 06.01.2021.

**2. Eligibility:** Master's degree in the respective subject/appropriate discipline of any recognized University/Institute or equivalent, with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate (of all the years/semesters) where marks are awarded or minimum equivalent Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) as defined by AICTE/UGC or any other competent body as the case may be.

- A relaxation of 5% or equivalent grade point in the minimum eligibility shall be applicable to the applicant belonging to the categories of SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) and Differently abled persons or categories decided by UGC or those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to September 19<sup>th</sup>, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace marks procedure.

**3. Disciplines/Subjects:** As per the notification No. JNVU/MPET/22/66 dated 21.11.2022.

**4. Entrance Examination Scheme:** The entrance test shall be of qualifying nature with qualifying marks as 50%. A relaxation of 5% will be given to those students who belong to SC/ST/OBC/Physically Challenged & visually impaired. The scheme for the entrance test shall consist of two parts, **PART-1: Research Methodology** & **PART-2: Subject Specific**. The paper shall consist of 100 objective type multiple choice questions, 50 questions from each part. Qualified candidates shall be called for interview/viva-voce before the DC to discuss their research interest/area and give a presentation on the same.

- **Duration of Examination: 3 Hrs(180 Minutes)**
- **No Negative Marking for Wrong Answer**
- **Processing Fee/Application Fee is NonRefundable.**

- **NET/SET/NET with JRF Qualified candidates are exempted from the MPET 2022 Examination however they can opt to appear in the MPET 2022 Examination. Online form & Fee are mandatory to fill for NET/JRF/SET Qualified candidates.**

**5. Weightage :** The weightage to the NET/SET/NET with JRF will be given as per details mentioned below: -

- (i) A weightage of 20 marks will be given to those students who have qualified NET with JRF within two years on the day of merit preparation by the respective department.
- (ii) A weightage of 10 marks be given to those students who have cleared only NET/SET and to those students who have NET with JRF, but date of fellowship expired (older than two years).

**6. Computation of Merit List :** A common merit will be prepared on the basis of following matrix: -

- (i)  $\{(PG \text{ percentage} + NET \text{ with JRF percentage}) \div 2\} + 20$  marks **(fulfilling Point 5 (i) mentioned above)**

OR

- $[ \{ PG \text{ percentage} + MPET \text{ (NET with JRF) percentage} \} \div 2 ] + 20$  marks **(fulfilling Point 5 (i) mentioned above)**

- (ii)  $\{(PG \text{ percentage} + NET/SET/Old JRF holder percentage) \div 2\} + 10$  marks **(fulfilling Point 5 (ii) mentioned above)**

OR

- $[ \{ PG \text{ percentage} + MPET \text{ (NET/SET/OLD JRF holder) percentage} \} \div 2 ] + 10$  marks **(fulfilling Point 5 (ii) mentioned above)**

- (iii)  $(PG \text{ percentage} + MPET \text{ percentage}) \div 2$  (excluding NET/SET/JRF)
